The RJC has developed a benchmark standard for the jewellery supply chain and credible mechanisms for verifying responsible business practices through 3rd party auditing.

As an RJC member, we commit to operating our business in accordance with the RJC Code of Practices. We commit to integrating ethical, human rights, social and environmental considerations into our day-to-day operations, business planning activities and decision-making processes.

As an RJC member, we fully support, respect and adhere to the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights. We are committed to responsible sourcing and we are sensitive to our supply chain structure. We strongly commit to supplying our goods from conflict-free areas in accordance with UN guidance on conflict-affected and high-risk areas (CAHRA).
